Did You Know?

- Worship is not just singing songs to God—it is an attitude of reverence, thankfulness, service, and praise that can be manifested in our lives every day (Luke 19:37-40).

Hamilton says, "Dig into God's Word"

Read Psalm 95:1-6. Remind your child that God is worthy of our worship because He is above all.

Tot Talk

Explain to your children that you can worship God in everything you do. Dancing, giving, art, singing, silence, sharing, and thanksgiving are just some of the ways we can worship Him.

Your child will learn by mimicking your actions. Allow her to imitate your posture as she watches you praise God for who He is in the everyday rhythm of your life.

Tot Talk

Share with your child the ways in which you worship God. Talk together about why we worship Him.
