Ponder Point

JESUS IS BORN

Blessing

Open a Bible and read Luke 2:14: "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to men on whom his favor rests."

Blessing

(Insert your child's name), may you give glory to God for the gift of His Son, Jesus.

Did You Know?

- The shepherds were the first to hear that Jesus had been born. God sent angels to tell them that the Savior had come.
- After seeing Jesus, the shepherds praised God because they knew He had kept His promise to send a Savior.

Hamilton says, "Dig into God's Word"

Read Luke 2:8-12. After reading, ask your child whom the shepherds found in the manger. It was Jesus! Remind your child that we celebrate Christmas because Jesus, the promised Savior, was born!

Tot Talk

Your child may enjoy playing with baby dolls. As she mimics caring for an infant, use this opportunity to tell her the Christmas story. Remind your child that Jesus was born as a baby.

Tot Talk

Who told the shepherds that Jesus had come? An angel shared the good news with them!

Were the shepherds happy or sad when they saw Jesus? How did they show how happy they were? They praised God!

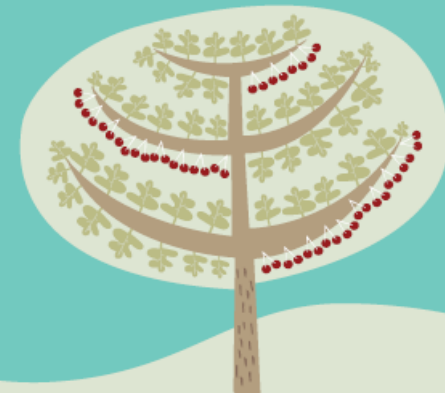
