Acts 12:1-19

King Herod imprisoned Peter, putting him under heavy guard while he awaited his trial. Peter's friends gathered to pray for him. God heard their prayers and sent an angel to free Peter from prison.

Ponder Point

GOD LISTENS TO OUR PRAYERS

Blessing

Open a Bible and read Matthew 19:26: "Jesus looked at them and said, '... with God all things are possible.'"

Blessing

(Insert your child's name), may you remember that no matter how hard something is, God can do anything, and He always listens to your prayers.

Did You Know?

- God sent an angel to lead Peter out of prison and to safety.
- When Peter first arrived at the house where his friends were praying, they didn't believe it was him!

Hamilton says, "Dig into God's Word"

Read Acts 12:4-7. After reading, remind your child that it was only through prayer that Peter's freedom was possible. You may also want to say that Peter was in jail, but not because he had made bad choices. He had only obeyed God and was making good choices!

Tot Talk

Your child can learn about prayer and may enjoy imitating you by folding her hands or kneeling to pray.

Tot Talk

Remind your child that prayer is simply talking to God.

What are some things you pray about? Do you think God is listening when you pray?

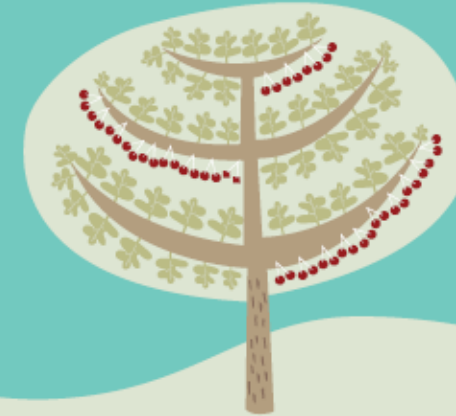
