Church Overview

Barrie Christian Community Church (BCCC) is a young and dynamic church, located in a fast-growing city with friendly residents and four-season lifestyle activities just north of Toronto GTA. The City of Barrie has a population about 150,000 where most are families with children. It is expected that the City will grow significantly in population in the next decade and beyond. Currently, Chinese residents represent the 3rd largest visible minority in the City.

BCCC currently offers Mandarin worship services and children program. Some of the families attending are Cantonese speaking. BCCC has a friendly and supportive ministry team made up by lay leaders and families.
