- To be part of the leadership team in leading the Barrie YLD Ministry to be the salt and light in the local community.

### **Qualifications**

- A mature Christian with a clear vision and passion to train up youth/children to build solid relationship with God.
- A full-time student in the Master of Divinity or equivalent program and will return to school in coming September.
- Some ministry experiences in leading/serving the children and youth ministry.
- Language skills: To be able to preach and teach in English. Mandarin or Cantonese speaking is an asset (with parents) but not necessary.
- Culture background: Knowledge in Canadian culture.
- Leadership skills: To be able to lead well and build a serving team for the summer program.
