Duties and Responsibilities

- 1) Report to the Barrie Campus Pastor and support the Barrie Ministry Committee (BMC) to reach out to the community in the City of Barrie and its surrounding areas for evangelism.
- 2) To work closely with the Barrie YLD Team by leading the Barrie YLD Ministry to be the salt and light in the local community
- 3) To lead and organize weekly Children Sunday schools and activities.
- 4) To plan, organize and run programs such as fellowship, VBS or church retreats, etc. for grade school students.
- 5) To attend related ministry meetings i.e. with pastoral staff, RHCCC YLD ministry as required.

Qualification

- 1) A mature Christian with clear vision and passion to guide and support the youth/children to build solid relationship with God.
- 2) Holding or working towards a University / College / Seminary degree or its equivalent in theological studies and/or youth ministry
- 3) Has at least 1 year experience in youth ministry or related fields.
- 4) To be able to preach and teach in English. Mandarin or Cantonese speaking is an asset (with parents) but not necessary.
- 5) To be able to build and lead a serving team in the YLD Ministry.
- 6) to be able to work well among the different teams.
- 7) Has good communication skills with co-workers, parents and youngsters; approachable personality.
- 8) Mature spiritual life and insights in communicating Bible truth
